## TAX BACK SCHEME FOR ELIGIBLE CHARITIES

We thank you for your continuing support of the Parish through your weekly, fortnightly, monthly or yearly contribution. The tax back scheme for eligible charities is a tax refund in respect of tax which you have already paid and will remain with Revenue if not claimed by a charity on your behalf. By completing the necessary CHY Certificate, the Parish of Raphoe as an eligible charity can claim this tax.

To qualify for this scheme, you must be a SELF-ASSESSED or a PAYE taxpayer and have donated  $\in$ 250 or more to the Parish in a year. Over the next two weeks or so you may get a CHY form in the post from Fr Kelly. It would be great if you would fill in your PPS number and sign it.

This form has no bearing on your tax. It only allows the parish to claim the tax you have already paid on your donation(s). your help in this matter is greatly appreciated. There will be no correspondence between the Parish and Revenue about you or your tax.

This has among other things, resulted in a reduction in the number of people proclaiming the Word of God, people helping to distribute Holy Communion and people participating in church choirs. Hopefully this trend will reverse. But we will have to wait and see if that happens. If you would like to have a particular role in the life of the parish you are invited to volunteer.
