The following courses are presented by the Raphoe Pastoral Centre, Monastery Avenue, Letterkenny.

Sycamore: There will be an online webinar for the parishes of the Diocese of Raphoe on Thursday 12 September 2024 at 7pm regarding the 'Sycamore' programme. One of the directors, Dr. Susan Longhurst will give a presentation as to what it is about, how to use it in parish etc. It will conclude with a Q&A. Alpha Day: On Saturday 12 October, there will be an Alpha Day at St. Patrick's Parish Centre, Donegal Town from 10.30am to 4pm. This will be open to all parishes in the Diocese. The day will include various talks and workshops etc for any parish that is interested in running the programme from a Catholic perspective.

Anchor Programme: On Tuesday 24 September at 7.30pm, Sr. Cooey Fowler will present the 'Anchor' programme at the Pastoral Centre in Letterkenny. This is a simple and foundational teaching about the essentials of the Faith, Mass and the ways in which we live and pray our Faith. It can be used by any adult and is also valuable for parents, to help them hand on to their children the treasure of the Catholic Faith.

Online Faith Formation Programme: From Wednesday 4 September, we will continue the online adult faith formation programmes on Zoom. This was a great success back in May and there has been increased demand for it from more parishes and parishioners around the Diocese. We will run this on a continuous basis throughout the year exploring various courses.

RCIA: The RCIA for those wishing to be formed for entry to the Catholic Church will begin on Monday 16 September 2024 at the Pastoral Centre in Letterkenny and will continue each Monday evening for 23 weeks.

PPC Refresher Courses: Beginning in the Autumn, it has been requested that the Parish Pastoral Council's in each Deanery come together over three evenings (1 evening a week for 3 weeks) for further formation and to learn from experiences so far. The focus of these gatherings will be on:

- 1) The unique role of the parish priest and the PPC's relationship to him.
- 2) The importance of prayer in PPC and how crucial it is in guiding all that we do.
- 3) The meaning of our baptismal calling and identity as priest, prophet and king, and how this applies to us in our lives and how it relates to our roles on the PPC's.

The Youth 2000 Summer Festival will take place in Clongowes Wood College, Co. Kildare (15 to 18 August). This is the largest Catholic youth event in the country and is for those between the ages of 16 to 35 years.
